Before the Foundation Of the World

Objective

Share what was in God's heart before He created the world. The object of His love was us, it was always us. When God made the world it was with us in His mind and heart. Compare this to the excitement they would feel about getting a new pet or a new baby in the family.

Teaching/ Activity

How many of you have a pet?

Let each child share what their pet is.

Do you remember how exciting it was to get your pet?

Where you happy to get your pet/pets?

What made you want to have a pet?

It was a desire in your heart, right?

You wanted a pet to love!

That is how God felt about you when He thought about having you for His child.

He was so happy and excited when He thought about you!

Show them a plastic toy elephant or a picture of an elephant. ([0-1 PP Creation Intro Week Activity](#))

Would you want an elephant for a pet?

No!

Why?

Show them a plastic toy tiger or a picture of a tiger.

Would you want a tiger for a pet?

No!

Why?

You wanted the right kind of pet.

You wanted a pet that you could have fun with and love, right?

Why?

Because that kind of pet made you very happy

Have a picture of different animals in a bag:

Hamster

Puppy

Kitten

Bunny

Bird

Hold each picture up and see if they know what animal it is.

Would this be a good pet?

Would you like to get another pet?

How would you feel if you got another pet?

That is the same way that God feels about you!
God wanted someone that would be just right for Him to love and take care of.
God wanted to have children to love!
God wanted YOU!

Do you know how long God was thinking about you?

Show the class a plastic toy giraffe or a picture of a giraffe.
Did God want a giraffe to be His child?
No!

Show the class a plastic toy horse or a picture of a horse.
Did God want a horse to be His child?
NO!

God wanted YOU!
You are perfect for God.
Do you know why?
Because you are just like Him!
God made you like Himself!
Show the children a picture of a baby.

Say this after me:
I ... I
Am ...Am
Like ... Like
God ... God

Are you like God?

YES!

Why?

Because He made you that way!

Once you knew what kind of pet you wanted, there were certain things your pet needed to have a good life in your family.

Hold up a hamster wheel.

If you have a dog for a pet does he need this?

No!

What pet likes to ride on this wheel?

A hamster!

So every different kind of pet needs different things to be happy.

Show the class a diaper or a picture of a diaper.

What is this?

If you have a hamster for a pet, does the hamster need a diaper? NO!

If you have a bird for a pet, does the bird need a diaper? NO!

Who needs a diaper?

A baby!

Show them a picture of a baby.

What are some other things a baby needs?

Baby bed, bottles, pacifier, car seat, small clothes,

Often the Mom and Dad will fix up the baby's room for them before they come home from the hospital because they are so excited about the new baby.

When you get a new family member, you want them to be happy and have everything they need.

God wanted you to have everything you needed to be happy also.
So God planned to create a world that would have everything you would need for life.
When God made you He was very happy.
He wanted to love you and take care of you.
He wanted to give you everything you needed.
So God made flowers and food to eat and the land for you to walk on.
He knew you needed those things for life and happiness.

Activity

Have a bag of pet supplies and things a baby would need.
Let each child take a turn to pick a supply out of the bag without looking in bag.
See if they know what the supply is and what pet it belongs to or if it is for a baby.

He wanted to give you everything you needed to be happy.

Did you need a hamster wheel to be happy?
Hold up a hamster wheel.
No!

In The Beginning

Objective

Remind the children that God was excited about creating the world because He was getting everything ready to make us. Just like we get excited about a new pet or a new baby coming into our family God was excited about having us be His children. Teach the children that the Bible is the word of God and it is where we find the truth. The Bible tells us how the world began. Many of our children are in the public school system and will be introduced to the evolution theory at an early age. We want them to know that the Bible tells us how the world was created by God. In today's lesson they will learn what God created on the first day. Many young children are afraid of the dark. Teach them that the dark is a gift from God also and it is good.

Teaching

Have you ever seen a house being built?

Do people use marshmallows to build houses?

No!

They use wood and nails, and maybe bricks.

What would happen if someone built a house with marshmallows?

It would fall over!

Do you like to build things?

Teaching/ Activity

Give each child some blocks and let them build something.

Let them play with the blocks as long as they are interested.

Pick up blocks.

Last week we talked about how excited we would be to get a new pet or a new baby brother or sister.

God was very excited about creating people to be His family.
He wanted children to love.

God knew just what we would need to live and be happy.

Today we are going to look at how God made a world that was just right for us to live in.

Did God use wood and nails to build the world?

No!

Do you know what God used to make the world?

WORDS!!

Can you see words?

No!

Can you hear words?

Yes!

Where do words come from?

Our mouths

Where is your mouth?

Let's look at how God used words to build our world.

Where are we going to look to find out how God made the world?

Where do we look to find the truth?

The Bible

Show them a Bible.

Why do we look in the Bible?

The Bible is the word of God.

It is different from every other book in the world.

God wrote the Bible.

The Bible teaches us the truth.

Today we are going to learn how the world was made.

The Bible tells us how the world was created on the very first page. (Show them)

Genesis 1:1

“In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.”

Who does the Bible say created the world?

God

Did it happen by accident?

No

There are many people that don’t believe God created the world.

They think it happened by accident.

That is why God gave us the Bible so we could know the truth.

What we read in the Bible is true.

If we hear something different from the Bible, it is a lie.

Let’s find out what God started out with.

Genesis 1:2

“And the earth was without form (worthless) and empty; and darkness was upon the face of the waters.”

Put a black poster on the wall with sticky tack.

Does it sound like a nice place to live?

Do you like the dark?
Why or why not?
Let them share.

Can you imagine what it would be like to be in the dark all the time?
It would be hard to do things without being able to see.

Ask the children to close their eyes.
Can you see anything?
That is the way the world was like before God began to make it.

God knew we need light to live on the earth.
God gave us everything we needed to be happy.

Let's look in the Bible again and find out what happened next.

Genesis 1:2
"And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters."

Put a white dove printed on cardstock on the black poster at the top with sticky tack.
([1-1 PP Creation Week 1 Picture of Dove](#))

The dove is a symbol for the Holy Spirit.
The Holy Spirit was ready to build a wonderful world.

Let's see what God did next.

Genesis 1:3-5

"And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. And God saw the light and it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness. And God called the light day and God called the darkness night. And that was the first day."

Put a white poster on the left side on top of the black poster board.

How did God create the light?
With His words!

And what happened when He spoke?
What He said happened!

What did God call the light? Day
What did God call the darkness? Night

So what did God do on the first day?
He created the light and separated it from the darkness

How did He do it?
With His words

Did God create the sun to give light? NO!
He just created the light with His words!

Night and Day

Show the class the finished craft.

Supplies:

Pens

Glue

White circles printed on cardstock

Black circles printed on cardstock

Bottle tops/Q-tips

Directions:

Give each child a white circle.

Help them write their name on it.

Give each child a black circle.

Give them glue in a bottle top and a Q-tip.

Have them glue the white circle on top of the black circle.

(Be careful that their name can be seen.

Show me the day time.

Show me the night time.

Set crafts aside to dry and take home.

Activity

We need light so we can see.

Light can also be a lot of fun.

Let's have some fun with light.

Turn the lights down in the class.

Give each child a small flashlight to play with.

God Continues to Create

Objective

Teach the children that on the second day God separated the water above the earth from the water on the earth. God called the space between them the sky. The rain was above the earth and the seas were on the earth. God made water for us to drink and play in. God made the air for us to breathe.

Teaching

Last week we found out that God created the light on the first day of creation.

Have the black poster on the eraser board (From week 1)

Have the dove at the top (From week 1)

Have the white poster on the left for light (From week 1)

Today we will find out what God created on the second day.

Where do we find the truth?

Bible- Hold up a Bible

Genesis 1:6-8 (NLT)

“And God **said**, ‘Let there be a space between the waters, to separate the waters of the heavens from the waters of the earth’. And that is what happened.”

God made this space to separate the waters of the earth from the waters of the heavens.
God called the space sky.
And that was the second day.”

Put the light blue cardstock on the left side of the eraser board on top of the white.
Put a few cotton balls on the light blue cardstock.

Put the dark blue cardstock on the left side at the bottom on top of the white poster board.

Do you know what we call the water that is up in the sky?
It is water up in the clouds.
Today we call it rain when it falls out of the clouds to the ground!

What do we call the water on the ground?
Oceans, seas, rivers

Do you like water?
Do you like the rain?
Is it fun to play in water?

What else do we do with water?
We drink it!
We take baths in water!

We swim in water!

God knew we needed water so He put some in the sky and He gathered some on the earth for us to drink and swim in.

God knew we would like water.
Water is a lot of fun.

God also made air for us to breathe in the sky.
Air is very important.
We need it to live.

Have the class hold their breaths.
You can't go very long without breathing!
The sky is very important for us.

Craft

On the Second Day

Supplies:

Finished craft

Light blue cardstock cut in the shape of a 2 ([2-1 PP Creation Week 2 Craft](#))

Cotton balls

Handi-wipes cut out to fit the bottom of the number 2

Glue

Bottle tops/Q-tips

Wipes for fast clean up

Directions

Put the finished craft on the wall for them to see. ([2-2 PP Creation Week 2 Finished Craft](#))

Give each child a blue cardstock 2.
Help them write their name on the back.

This is the number 2.

Count with them...one, two

On the second day of creation God created the sky and separated the water above the earth from the water on the earth.

Give each child a bottle top filled with glue and a Q-tip.

Give them 3 cotton balls.

Have them glue the cotton balls at the top of the number two.

These are clouds that hold the water above the earth.

Do you like the rain?

Have you ever played in the rain?

When the clouds get heavy with water today it falls out of the clouds and we call that rain.

Bring out the spray bottle.

Ask if anybody would like to get gently sprayed.

If they do, make it fun and give them a squirt!!

Next have them put glue at the bottom of the 2.

Then give them the Handi-wipe to glue on the 2.

Have them notice the waves in the Handi-wipe.

That is the water in the oceans.

Set crafts aside to dry and take home when class is over.

God Likes Dirt!

Objective

Teach the children that God made the dry land and the trees, flowers, and the grass on the third day of creation. God knew we would need the ground to walk on and food to eat. He also wanted to give us beautiful flowers to look at.

Teaching

Have the black poster on the wall low so the children can reach it. (From week 1)

God wanted to make a wonderful place for us to live that was beautiful. The earth was dark and not a nice place. But the Holy Spirit had a good plan.

Put the white dove above the black poster using sticky tack. (From week 1)
A dove is a symbol for the Holy Spirit)

God knew we needed light so He said, Let there be light and there was light. And God saw the light and it was good.

Put the white poster over the black poster on the left side. (From week 1)

God divided the light from the darkness.

He called the light day.

He called the darkness night.

Then God made the sky to separate the water up high from the water on the earth.

Put the light blue poster on top of the white poster at the top for the sky. (From week 2)

Put 3 cotton balls on the light blue poster for clouds (From week 2)

Put the dark blue poster on top of the white poster at the bottom for the oceans.
(From week 2)

God made the air for us to breathe and the water for us to drink and bathe in and swim in.

Today we will find out what God made next.
What else do you think we needed?

What do you have at the end of your legs?
Feet!
What do you use your feet for?
Walking

God hasn't made the ground yet.
There wasn't anything to walk on yet!
What would it be like if there was only water and nothing for you to walk on?

God knew we needed to walk on the ground.
He made the land on the third day.

Put the brown poster on top of the dark blue poster.

Activity

Supplies:

Plastic tablecloth

Kinetic sand (Hobby Lobby/ Walmart or Amazon.com)

[\(3-1 PP Creation Week 3 Kinetic Sand\)](#)

Have the class sit on the tablecloth and give them each some kinetic sand.
Let them play with it for a little while.

God made the ground for us to walk on and build houses and streets.

God made many wonderful things that could grow in the ground.
He made all kinds of trees.
Many of them had food on them to eat.

Put the tree on the brown poster.
[\(3-2 PP Creation Week 3 Pictures for wall\)](#)

God also made grass for the animals to eat and flowers for us to look at.

Put the grass and flowers on the brown poster.

Do you have any trees in your yard?
God made them.

Do you have grass in your yard?
God made it

God Made a Wonderful World for Us ([3-3 PP Creation Week 3 Craft](#))

Supplies:

Finished Craft
Blue Cardstock for the water
Brown poster for the ground
Plastic tree/Foam grass/Plastic flowers
Craft Title/Scripture for craft
Bottle tops of glue
Q-tips

Directions:

Show the class the finished craft.

Give each child a craft page
Tell them the blue is for the water
Help them write their name on the front.

Give them bottle top of glue and a Q-tip.
Give them the craft title and have them glue it at the top.
Read it to them.

Give them the Scripture to go with the craft.
Have them glue it in place.
Read it to them.

Give them brown poster to glue on the blue cardstock.
Tell them that is the ground.

Have a bag of fruits and vegetables.

Hide them around the classroom and let the children find them.

Ask them if they know what they found and if they like to eat it.

Fourth Day of Creation

Objective

Remind the children what God created on the first three days of creation. Teach them that the Bible is the place to find out how the world was made. Teach them that God made the sun, moon, and the stars on the fourth day of creation.

Teaching

Have the black/white poster, dove, (From week 1)

Have the light/dark blue posters/3 cotton balls (From week 2)

Have the brown poster, tree, grass and flowers (From week 3) on the wall low enough for children to touch.

On the first day of creation God made the light and He separated the light from the dark.

Have one child point to the day.

Have one child point to the night.

On the second day of creation, God made the sky to separate the water up above from the water on the earth.

Have one child point to the water up above in the clouds.

Have one child point to the water below in the oceans.

Week 4 Fourth Day of Creation

On the third day of creation, God made the ground for us to walk on.
He also made the trees with food, grass and flowers.

Have one child point to the ground (brown poster).
Have one child point to the tree.
Have one child point to the grass.
Have one child point to the flower.

Today we are going to find out what God made on the fourth day of creation.
Can you guess what He made next?

Genesis 1:14 ([4-1 PP Creation Pictures for wall](#))

“And God made two great lights, the greater to rule the day (**Put the sun on the light blue poster**) and the lesser light to rule the night. (**Put the moon on the black side**). He made the stars also. (**Put the stars on the black side**) and God set them in the firmament of the heaven to give light on the earth, to rule over the day and over the night and to divide the light from the darkness and God saw that it was good.”

Point to the greater light.
What do we call the greater light?
Sun!
When do we see the sun?
Daytime

Point to the lesser light.
What do we call the lesser light?
Moon!
When do we see the moon?
At night!

Pull out a big picture of the sun. ([4-2 PP Creation Week 4 Teaching](#))

Who likes the sunshine?

Do you like to play outside when it is sunny?

Does the sun make you feel hot or cold?

HOT!

So the sun gives us light, but it also gives us warmth.

The earth would be a very cold place to live if we didn't have the sun.

The sun also gives us vitamins that help us stay strong and healthy.

Pull out a big picture of the moon. ([4-2 PP Creation Week 4 Teaching](#))

Who likes the dark?

Find out why they feel the way they do.

So do you like night lights?

How many of you have a night light in your room?

How does a night light help you?

- You can see better
- You aren't afraid
- You can go to sleep easier with a night light

Plug in a night light and turn it on.

Now turn out the lights in the room

That is why God gave us the moon.

He wanted us to have darkness at night so we could sleep better.

He knew the earth needed to be able to cool down.

The moon is our night light!

Craft ([4-3 PP Creation Week 4 Craft](#))

It's the Fourth Day of Creation

Supplies:

Finished Craft
Black plates (with white back)
Yellow circles (sun)
Yellow strips (sun rays)
White circles (moon)
Plastic glow in the dark stars
Creation 4 Title
Bottle tops/Q-tips
Glue
Wipes

Show the class the finished craft.

Give each child a black paper plate.

Tell them one side of the plate will be the daylight and the other the night.

Give out the bottle tops of glue and a Q-tip.
Give them 10 strips to glue around outside of sun.

Give them a yellow sun to glue in the center of the white side of the plate.

Is this the daylight or the night time side of the plate?

Take the preschoolers outside but keep them away from the older class for this activity.
While the older class is flying their paper planes, give each preschooler a bottle of bubbles.

Teacher opens bottle of bubbles/dips the wand in and pulls it out.

Ask the class what else do we need to make a bubble?

Air!

We need to blow air through the wand to make the bubbles!

Teacher blows bubbles for class to see.

Would you like to have fun with the air making bubbles too?

Give each child a bottle of bubbles and a wand.

Let them blow bubbles until the older class is finished flying the airplanes.

If there is someone in the congregation that is going to fly a remote plane, let the class stay and watch the demonstration.

If not bring the children back to class.

Give them a foam Popsicle stick.

Cover half of it with glue and put the foam monkey on top.

(These are small children so be sure the snake isn't scary looking. I found one that was pink and kind of cute at Dollar Tree!)

The snake came and told Eve that the tree of the knowledge of good and evil was a good tree that had good fruit to eat.

He tried to trick her into eating its fruit by telling her if she ate from the tree she would be like God.

Did he tell her the truth?

No!

Adam and Eve were already like God because God made them like Him.

Do you know who the snake was?

It was the devil.

He was trying to get Adam and Eve to believe a lie and not believe what God said to them.

When God made Adam and Eve He made them like He was.

They were already like Him just like this is already a balloon.

They couldn't do anything to make themselves more like God.

When God made Adam and Eve they didn't have to try to be good.

They were already good because they were like God.

God made Adam and Eve good.

God made all people good like Himself.

They didn't have to **do** anything to be good.

God didn't want us trying to be something we already were, just like this balloon is already a balloon.

Remember how God rested after He made the world.

He didn't rest because He was tired.

He rested because He made everything just the way it should be...good!

God also wanted Adam and Eve to rest and be happy with how He made them.

He likes being with you all the time.

You make Him happy!!

Show them the happy face. ([16-2 PP Creation Week 16 Teaching Happy Sad Face](#))

Adam and Eve made God happy too.

He made them just like Him so they could live with Him forever.

But the devil, dressed up like a snake (hold up a snake that isn't scary looking!) tricked them into believing that they were not like God.

Did the devil trick God too?

NO!

God knew Adam and Eve were still like Him.

The devil can't trick God.

That is what Adam and Eve did.
They tried to hide from God.

Read this story to them.
Have them act out the story if they want to.
