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# ***A New Life Called Death***

## **Objective**

Remind the children that God had a wonderful plan to spend His life with Adam and Eve and all people. But when Adam and Eve believed the lies of the devil, they hid from God. They didn't believe they were like God. Tell the children that God had a plan to free Adam and Eve and all people from the devil's lies.

## **Teaching**

God had a wonderful plan.  
He created a beautiful world for Adam and Eve to live in.  
It was called the Garden of Eden.

There were many wonderful things in the garden.  
There were trees with food on them and beautiful flowers everywhere.  
Show the class an artificial piece of fruit and a flower.

There were many different kinds of animals and they got along with each other.  
Show them a plastic animal.

God made Adam and Eve like Himself.  
He wanted a family to love and be with.



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Bring out a stuffed pretend snake, that doesn't look scary.  
But then something went wrong in the garden.  
Who knows what went wrong?  
See if they can say what they think went wrong.

The devil came in the form of a snake and lied to Eve.  
He told her she was not like God.  
He told her if she ate the fruit of a certain tree then she would be like God.

She believed the snake.  
She and Adam both ate the fruit from the tree God told them would kill them.

God sent Adam and Eve out of the garden to protect them from the devil.  
But they were sad now.

Show a sad face. ([1-1 PP Salvation Week 1 Sad Face](#))

They felt bad about themselves.  
They didn't think they were like God.  
They thought God was unhappy with them.

Can you make a sad face?

Were Adam and Eve still like God? YES  
Was God still happy with them? YES  
But they didn't believe it.

They saw everything through the lies of the devil.  
It is like looking through sunglasses.  
Everything looks different.



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Give each child a pair of sunglasses to put on.  
What happens when you put on the sunglasses?  
Does everything look the same? NO!

That is what happened to Adam and Eve.  
When they believed they were not like God, everything looked different to them.  
Everything looked bad to them.

They thought they were bad.

Bring out a picture of a caterpillar. ([1-2 PP Salvation Week 1 Picture of Caterpillar](#))  
Do you know what this is?  
What does it do?  
Is it pretty?

That is how Adam and Eve felt.  
They thought they were like a caterpillar.

They didn't know they were still like God.  
They felt like all they could do was crawl around on the ground.  
They felt bad about themselves and hid from God.

Do you know how to hide?  
Let me see you hide your face from me!  
Can you hide from me?  
Let the children get up and hide in the room.



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That is what Adam and Eve did with God?  
They hid from Him because they felt bad about themselves.  
They felt like a caterpillar, ugly and crawling in the dirt!

#### **Craft**

Let's make a caterpillar.

#### **Supplies:**

Wooden clothespins  
Colored pom-poms  
Wiggly eyes already glued onto a pom-pom  
Glue  
Bottle tops  
Q-tips  
Round magnets

#### **Directions:**

Show them the finished craft. ([1-3 PP Salvation Week 1 Finished Craft](#))

Give each child a clothespin.  
Help them write their name on one side of it.

First they need to pick out the head pom-pom that already has wiggly eyes glued on to it.  
Give them a bottle top filled with glue and a Q-tip.  
Have them glue the pom-pom onto the front of the clothespin.

Let them pick out the colors of pom-poms they want to use to make the rest of their caterpillar.  
They will need 3 more pom-poms.  
Help them glue the 3 pom-poms onto the clothespin.

Next give them a round magnet.  
Have them put glue on the non-magnetic side and put the clothespin on it.



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Set aside to dry and take home.

Use wipes for fast clean up.

God was sad that Adam and Eve felt bad about themselves and hid from Him.

Show the class the sad face again.

God had a plan to help Adam and Eve know the truth.

He wanted them to know they were just like God.

He wanted them to know they were wonderful.

God wants us to know that we are just like Him also.

He wants us to know that we are wonderful.

We will find out about God's plan in a couple of weeks.

We will also learn more about the caterpillar.

#### **Ministry**

Pray

Thank You God that I am just like You. Thank You that You are always happy with me. Thank You for loving me so much. Thank You for saving me from the lies of the devil and filling me with Your life.

Pray for any other needs they have.

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**Week 2 Hiding From God**

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# *Hiding From God*

## **Objective**

Help the children understand a little deeper about what it looks like to hide from God, using the caterpillar and a cocoon.

## **Teaching**

Teacher is wearing sunglasses to begin lesson.

Last week we talked about how Adam and Eve were tricked by the devil to believe that they were not like God.

They thought they were bad and it made them hide from God.

When they believed the lie, it was like they were looking through glasses that made everything look different than what God had said to them.

Just like when you wear sunglasses everything looks darker than it really is.

God made Adam and Eve good just like Him.

God made you good and just like Him also.

When Adam and Eve believed they were bad they hid from God.

When Adam and Eve hid from God they couldn't receive His love.





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**Skit**

Have the teacher or helper pretend to be God.

Have a child pretend to be Adam or Eve.

Props:

Gold crown

A tri-fold display board like used for science fair projects

Age appropriate candy

The person pretending to be God puts the crown on their head.

Have God holding a piece of candy.

Put the child who is Adam behind the tri-fold board.

God wants to give Adam His love.

Have God hold the candy out.

The candy won't go through the tri-fold board.

God tells them how much He loves them but they can't receive it.

He keeps trying to give them the candy, but they can't get it.

God is sad.

Adam is sad.

God is sad because He wants to give something wonderful to Adam and He can't because Adam is hiding from Him.



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Adam is sad because He can't get the good things that God has for him.

Why is Adam hiding from God?

Because he feels bad about himself and he thinks God is mad at him.

Did God t want Adam and Eve to hide from Him? No!

He doesn't want us to hide from Him either.

God likes us to be with Him all the time.

God sent Jesus to show us we didn't need to hide from God ever.

**Story**

Last week we made some caterpillars.

Today we are going to learn more about caterpillars.

First we are going to read a story about a caterpillar.

**Read The Very Hungry Caterpillar by Eric Carl.**

**Stop reading the story when the caterpillar is in the cocoon.**

**We will finish the story next week.**

Did you like that story?

What was your favorite part?

What food did you like that the caterpillar ate?



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Are you sad that we didn't finish the story?  
Do you want the caterpillar to stay in the cocoon?  
NO!  
You want to see him be set free.

That is just how God felt about Adam and Eve and all people.  
He didn't want them to keep hiding from Him.

He wanted to set Adam and Eve free.  
He wants to set us free from the lies of the devil too.

#### **Craft**

##### **Supplies:**

Finished Craft ([2-1 PP Salvation Week 2 Finished Craft](#))

Pre-made caterpillars

Toilet paper rolls

Paper towels

We are going to let our caterpillars go hide in their cocoon also, just like in the story.

If you were here last week you made a caterpillar.

We are going to give you another caterpillar today to put in a cocoon.

Let them pick out the caterpillar they want.

What does a caterpillar do?

It crawls around on the ground and it eats.

Can it move very fast? No



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A caterpillar can't see very well either.  
When he gets big and fat he goes and hides in a cocoon.

Give each child a toilet paper roll.  
This is going to be the cocoon for the caterpillar to hide in.

Have them put their caterpillar into the toilet paper roll.  
Can you see the caterpillar now?  
No!  
He is hiding.

That is just what Adam and Eve did with God.  
They hid from Him.  
That made them sad and it made God sad also.

Hold up the sad face. ([2-2 PP Salvation Week 2 Sad Face](#))

Now we are going to wrap the caterpillar in the cocoon.  
Give each child a piece of paper towel.  
Have them roll the toilet paper roll in the paper towel and twist the ends closed.

But God had a plan to free Adam and Eve from the devil's lies that they were bad.  
God didn't want them to hide from Him.

He wanted them to be free and to know how wonderful they were.  
God wanted them to be happy.  
Show them the happy face. ([2-3 PP Salvation Week 2 Happy Face](#))



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God wants you to be free from the lies of the devil too.

He wants you to know how wonderful you are.

He wants you to know He is always happy with you.

Hold up the happy face.

Next week we will find out how the caterpillar makes his cocoon and what happens when he comes out of it.

Pray:

Thank You God for saving me from the lies of the devil. Thank You that I don't ever have to hide from You. Thank You Jesus for dying on the cross so I could have Your life and live in Your love.

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# ***New Life***

## **Objective**

Show the class how God planned to give Adam and Eve new life, a life that is ours to experience also. Instead of hiding from God like a caterpillar does in a cocoon we can be free to be ourselves. We don't ever have to hide from God. He made us the way we are and IT IS GOOD!!

## **Teaching**

Who remembers what animal we have been learning about?  
A caterpillar!

Last week we started reading The Very Hungry Caterpillar  
Today we are going to finish the story.

## **Read The Very Hungry Caterpillar**

Did you like that story?

What did the caterpillar become?  
A beautiful butterfly

## **Craft**

Today we are going to turn our caterpillars into butterflies.  
Would you like to do that?

#### ***Week 3 New Life***

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\*\*\*Have a few extras made already in case new children are in class that weren't last week

#### **Supplies:**

Pre-made caterpillars from week 1  
Colored butterfly foam shapes  
Different colored hearts  
Glue  
Bottle tops  
Q-tips

#### **Instructions:**

Show the class the finished craft. ([3-1 PP Salvation Week 3 Finished Craft](#))

Let the class pick out the caterpillar they want for the craft. ([3-2 PP Salvation Week 3 Caterpillars](#))

(Clothespin with pom-poms)

Next, let them choose the colors they want to make their caterpillar's wings.  
(Foam butterflies)

Give them a bottle top with glue and a Q-tip  
Help them glue the body of the caterpillar on top of the foam caterpillar shape.

Have the class pick out the colored hearts they want.  
Have them glue the hearts onto the butterfly wings.

Set aside to dry.  
Take home when class is over.



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#### **Week 3 New Life**

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Show the class a picture of a caterpillar and a butterfly. (Use the pictures provided or you can find your own on the internet.)

[\(3-3 PP Salvation Week 3 Caterpillar Butterfly\)](#)

Does the caterpillar look anything like a butterfly?

No!

Which one do you think is prettier?

Does the caterpillar act like the butterfly?

Can the caterpillar fly? No!

The caterpillar crawls on the ground and moves very slowly.

The caterpillar can't see very well.

He has to feel around to find food to eat.

But a butterfly can see very well from up in the air.

The caterpillar won't go very far from where it hatched from its egg.

But a butterfly can fly 2000 miles to get to a warmer climate for the winter!

Let's watch a caterpillar turn into a beautiful monarch butterfly.

If not available show them the stages in pictures.

When Adam and Eve believed the devil's lies, they thought they were ugly, like the caterpillar.

They didn't think they were like God.



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#### ***Week 3 New Life***

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Jesus came to show them they were beautiful and to give them new life, just like the caterpillar receives new life when it becomes a butterfly. It no longer crawls around on the ground but it is free to fly in the sky.

Jesus wants us to know that we are beautiful.

That He had us good.

Who you are is good!

You are like God because He made you that way!

#### **Ministry**

Thank You God for sending Jesus to the earth to give me new life, Your life. Thank You for showing me that I am just like You and that I am Your child.

Pray for any other needs the children have.

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# ***Having God's Life***

## **Objective**

God wants all His children to have His life. God's life is full of love and joy and peace all the time.

## **Teaching**

Read the story of the Very Hungry Caterpillar

Do you think the caterpillar was happier as a caterpillar or a butterfly?  
Why?

God wants us to have His kind of life.

He wants us to be filled with His joy and His peace and His love.

Just like the butterfly flies high in the air above the earth, God's life for us helps us live above any problems that we have.

What does God's life look like?

God's life always tells us the truth.

God's life tells us that we are just like God.

It tells us that God is always happy with us.

It tells us we are one with God.

God's life is full of love and joy and peace.



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***Week 4 Having God's Life***

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Who wants God's life?      Yeah!

**Craft**

**Supplies:**

Butterfly paint pages

Paint brushes

Small cups for water

Clean water

Buckets with clean water and for dirty water

Paint smocks

**Directions:**

Have several pages of a paint book with butterflies in it.

Have the pages already pulled out of the book.

Let each child pick a page they want to paint.

Give each child a cup of water and a paint brush.

Have more water on hand if their water gets dirty.

Set painted pages aside to dry and take home when class is over.

Thank You God for giving me Your life. Thank You for giving me Your love, Your truth and Your joy.

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# ***Who Are You Married To?***

## **Objective**

Help the class understand that marriage means you become one with someone else. When Adam and Eve believed the devil's lies they became one with his belief system. Jesus died on the cross to free us from that belief system. Now we can choose to become one with God and His belief system.

## **Teaching**

Supplies:

Plastic jar of water with lid

Red food coloring

Wedding doll

2 Wedding grooms, one marked up to look ugly

Bring a plastic jar of clean water and red food coloring out for the class to see.

Add a few drops of the red food coloring to the water.

What happens?

The plain water and red color become one.

They can't be separated.

When Adam and Eve believed the devil's lies, they became married to the lies of the devil and they couldn't get free.

They became one with that belief system.

When you marry someone you become one with them.



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#### ***Week 5 Who Are You Married To?***

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Do you remember what Satan believes?

He says that you are not like God; you have to try hard to become like God.

He says when you do something wrong God is upset with you.

His belief tells you that you are not perfect and complete.

It tells you that you are bad when you do something wrong.

Bring out the ugly groom doll.

This is the devil and what he believes.

Adam and Eve and all people became one with the devil's lies.

The devil told Eve bad things about her.

He told her she was ugly and not like God.

Bring out the bride and have her head looking down.

The devil told her God was mad at her.

It was a lie but she believed it.

Then all people were stuck in the devil's lies.

Jesus defeated the devil when He died on the cross and rose from the dead.

But the devil's lies are still in this world.

He tells you that you are not like God; you have to try hard to become like God.

He tells you when you do something wrong God is upset with you.

He tells you that you are not perfect and complete.

He tells you that you are bad when you do something wrong.

Those are all LIES.

But God and Jesus had a plan and it was good.

The plan was for Jesus to die away all the lies the devil told us on the cross.

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#### ***Week 5 Who Are You Married To?***

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Then Jesus would show us how wonderful and perfect we were when He was raised from the dead.

He would come and set us free from the devil's lies and show us we were just like Him.

Bring out the clean bridegroom.

We are going to pretend that this is Jesus.

Jesus wanted to be our bridegroom.

He came to rescue us from the devil's lies.

Jesus came and told us the truth about ourselves.

He told us we were His beautiful bride.

Then we could be married to Jesus and become one with God.

And we could believe the truth that God said about us, which is you are beautiful, you are just like God.

Then we could live in God's life that He had for us.

And Jesus gave us flowers (give the bride the flowers) and shoes (put the shoes on her feet) and a tiara (put the tiara on her head) and a necklace to wear (put the necklace around her neck).

Then we could be happy and know that we were one with God and just like Him.

We can be married to God now and forever.

Who do you want to be married to?

Hold up the ugly groom (the devil)

Do you want to be married to the devil and his lies?

Hold up the groom that is Jesus. (Remind them that we are pretending that this is Jesus)

Or do you want to be married to Jesus and His love and truth about you?

Do you want to live in God's life?

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# ***No Mixture!***

## **Objective**

Help the children to understand that mixing God's belief system and the devil's belief system is bad.

## **Teaching**

Hold up a single serving container of Jell-O.

Do you know what this is?

Do you like Jell-O?

Ask the class if they would like some Jell-O to eat.

**Give them each a container of Jell-O and spoon to eat some.**

Before they get to eat it, **bring out a cup of dirt.**

**Sprinkle a small spoon of dirt in the Jell-O.**

Ask them why they don't want to eat the Jell-O now.

I thought you liked Jell-O.

But I just put a little dirt in the Jell-O.

A little dirt won't cause a problem!

So why don't you want to eat a little dirt with your Jell-O?

A little dirt makes all the Jell-O bad doesn't it?



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***Week 6 No Mixture!***

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**Give them each another container of Jell-O and a clean spoon to eat it with.**  
Let them know this Jell-O has no dirt in it!

Today we are going to talk about mixing things.  
You didn't like me mixing your Jell-O with dirt, did you?

The same thing happens when you mix a little of the devil's lies with God's truth.

What does God's truth say to you?  
God is happy with you all the time.  
You are just like God.  
You are perfect and complete.  
You don't have to do anything to become like God!

**Activity**

But when you mix a little of the devil's lies with God's truth this is what it sounds like:  
**Bring out a daisy.**

Let the children take turns pulling the petals off as you read the lies and truths.  
God is happy with me.

I am just like God.  
I am not like God.  
I am perfect and complete.  
There is something wrong with me  
God is happy with me.  
God is not happy with me.



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***Week 6 No Mixture!***

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**Now pull out another daisy.**

Let the children take turns pulling the petals off as you read the truths.

This daisy just has God's truth:

God is happy with me.

I am just like God.

I am perfect and complete.

God is happy with me.

I am just like God.

I am perfect and complete.

Keep repeating those truths until all the petals are pulled off.

God is always the same.

He never changes.

He is always happy with you.

**Craft** ([6-1 PP Salvation Week 6 Craft](#))

No Mixture: Do Not Mix the Devil's Lies With God's truth.

Just like you didn't want to eat Jell-O mixed with dirt, we don't want to mix the lies of the devil with God's truth.

**Supplies:**

Finished Craft ([6-2 PP Salvation Week 6 Finished Craft](#))

Craft Cardstock pages

Pictures of Jell-O

Pictures of sad faces

Small plastic spoons

Dirt

Glue

Bottle tops

Q-tips

Sheet protectors

**Directions:**

Show the class the finished craft.

Remind them of the activity with the Jell-O earlier.

**Give each child a craft page.**

Help them write their name on the back.

**Give each child a picture of Jell-O**

Do you remember eating Jell-O earlier?

**Give each child a bottle top of glue and a Q-tip.**

Have them look at the finished craft.

**Have them glue the Jell-O in the middle of the page.**

**Give each child a spoon and a tiny amount of dirt.**

**Have them put the glue on the spoon and then pour the dirt in the glue!**

Let that dry for a few minutes.

**Help them put a little glue falling down into the Jell-O.**

(See finished craft)

Have them sprinkle a little dirt on the glue.

**Help them glue the spoon of dirt right above the dirt on the page.**

Do we ever want to mix the devil's lies with God's truth?  
No!

God's truth makes us happy.  
It fills us with God's love and life.

God's truth says:

- You Are Like God
- God is Always Happy With You
- You Are Perfect and Complete

**What do the devil's lies tell us?**

- You Are Not Perfect and Complete
- You Are Not Like God
- You have to do something to become like God
- God is Not Happy With You

Does that make you happy?  
Does that give you God's life?  
No!  
That makes you sad.

**Give them the sad face to glue on the page.**

Whenever you hear something that makes you feel bad about yourself or that God is not happy with you that is a lie.

We never want to mix the devil's lies with God's truth.  
It is like mixing dirt and Jell-O!

Set crafts aside to dry and take home when class is over.

Put in sheet protectors to take home to avoid a mess. (and unhappy parents!)

**Ministry**

Are you like God?      Yes!

Why?

Because God made you that way!

Is God always happy with you?      Yes!

Why?

Because you are perfect and complete in Him!

You are His child.

Pray:

Thank You God for making me just like You and always being happy with me. Thank You for dying on the cross for me so I can have Your life. Thank You for taking away my sin. I choose to live in Your truth and love.

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# ***Who God Is And Who I Am Do Not Change!***

## **Objective**

Continue to expose the dangers of mixing Satan's belief system (we are what we do, what we have and what has happened to us) with God's belief system (We are who God says we are, His children perfect and complete full of His honor and glory, just like Him.)

## **Teaching**

Who remembers what mixture is?

Do you remember last week we mixed Jell-O and dirt together?

Did you want to eat that? No!

Why didn't you want to eat it?

Because something bad was mixed with something good

That ruins what good was there.

Some mixtures are good.

**Take a deep breath.**

What did you breathe in?

Air

Was that good?

Yes, you need it to live.

#### ***Week 7 Who God Is And Who I Am Do Not Change!***

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How long can you hold your breath?

**Let them try to hold their breath if they want to.**

Air is a mixture of gases and we need that mixture to live!

We can't live very long without breathing air!

Most of your toys are a mixture of different kinds of plastics, coloring and metals.

Bring out a toy and show them the plastic part, the different colors and the metal part.

Some mixtures are fun!

**Bring out a container of play dough.**

Play dough is made up of a mixture.

It is made of water, salt, flour and wheat.

**Give each child a container of Play dough to play with for a little while.**

Let them tell you what they are making.

So some mixtures are fun.

But some mixtures are very bad, like dirt and Jell-O!

When we mix what the devil says about us with what God says about us it causes many problems.

What does the devil say about you?

- You are not like God
- God is unhappy with you sometimes

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- You have to try hard to be like God
- You are not the way you ought to be

What does God say about you?

- You are just like Him
- He is always happy with you  
You are His child
- He loves being with you

What happens when we mix all those things together?

Do you remember the daisies from last week?

We get all confused.

Sometimes we think we are like God and sometimes we think we are not like God.

Sometimes we think God is happy with us and sometimes we think He is not happy with us.

When you don't know who you are that is a BIG problem.

Pick a child that is comfortable in class.

Ask them what their name is?

What will your name be tomorrow?

What will your name be the next day?

Will your name change next week?

Why not?

Because you are the same person every day!

If someone came up to you and said your name is (give them another name), would you believe them?

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Why not?

Because you are smart!

You know what your name is!

You know who you are!

You are not (their name) one day and (another name) the next day, are you?

That is silly isn't it?

You wouldn't know who you were, if that happened!

That is just what the devil wanted to happen in the garden with Adam and Eve.

He didn't want them to know who they were.

He didn't want them to know they were God's children and just like God.

Guess what?

The devil doesn't want you to know who you are either!

He doesn't want you to know that you are just like God and that you always will be like God!

And you know what else?

The devil also doesn't want you to know who God is!

He wants you to think that God changes all the time!

The devil doesn't want you to know that God is happy with you all the time.

Do you have to listen to the lies of the devil?

No!

**Have them put their fingers in their ears!**

When you hear that you are not like God or that God isn't happy with you, you know that is a LIE!

Give them the picture of God.

Have them glue it on the right side of the page.

Give each child a God Does Not Change Either/God Is Always Himself/God is Always Happy With Me card

Have them glue it on the bottom of the right side of the page.

I Am Always God's Child.

I am Always Like God.

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# *Who Did Jesus Come To Save?*

## **Objective**

You wouldn't want to go to the zoo if all the animals were cats and they all looked the same.

That is why God made so many different kinds of animals for us...so it would be fun to see all the ways they are different and enjoy them.

You might want to hold a little puppy on your lap (show them a picture of a small puppy) but you wouldn't want to hold an elephant would you? (Show them a picture of an elephant)

Why?

It's too big!

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It is the same way with people.

God made lots of people and none of them look exactly alike.

They are different sizes, shapes and colors, and God loves them all.

Bring out 10 pictures of different people that have been laminated.

You can select pictures from the internet.

(Boy, girl, man, woman, black person, Indian person, white person, Chinese person, Mexican person, Hispanic person.)

Show them the pictures of the boy and girl.

How are they different?

Show them the pictures of the boy and man.

How are they different?

Show them the pictures of a white and black person.

How are they different?

Show them the rest of the pictures and tell them the person's race and where they might live.

Is it okay to be different?

Yes!

God loves to make everyone different.

Does God love everyone?

Yes!

Is everyone special?

Yes!

**Give each child a red foam heart and a bottle top with glue and a Q-tip.**

Help them glue the bottom of the heart onto the yellow cardstock square above the scripture.

**Give each child a blue foam circle to glue in the middle of the red heart.**

This is the world.

**Give them green foam to glue on the blue circle to make the continents.**

The green foam is the different lands the people live on.

**Next give them each 4 different foam children.**

Have them pull the adhesive off the backs and put around the top of the heart.

(Look at finished craft)

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# *There Are Only Two Choices*

## **Objective**

Teach the class that there are only 2 belief systems in the world: God's belief system and the devil's belief system. Only God's belief system will give you God's life now and forever.

## **Teaching**

When we want to go to the store, we get in the car and what takes us to the store?

The road

We have to drive our car on a road and if we stay on the right road we will get to the store.

Today we are going to talk about the road that takes us to living with God forever.

When we believe the way God believes, it takes us to heaven.

When we believe what the devil believes, it won't take us to heaven.

We are going to make a pretend road in this room and follow it to heaven.

Won't that be fun?

I will need your help to build the road.

## **Activity** ([9-1 PP Salvation Week 9 Activity](#))

Pick the spot in the class where heaven is going to be.

Mark it with a big red heart with a happy face.

Tell the kids this is our pretend heaven. This is where God is taking us to.

When Jesus comes back to the earth He is going to bring heaven with Him!

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Put several different colored rectangle shapes of foam on the table.  
Let the children pick out a color they want to put down first.

Help them start laying down the colored rectangles one at a time to the heart.  
How do we get on this road to heaven and God's life?  
By believing what Jesus did on the cross for us

What did Jesus do on the cross for us?  
He washed away all our sins.  
He separated us from the devil's lies.  
He gave us His place in heaven with Him.  
We don't have to do anything, Jesus did it all for us!

Now there is another road that leads away from heaven and God's life.  
Show them the black square with the sad face on it.  
This is the pretend place away from God.

Do you want to be away from God?  
NO!

Have the children walk to heaven stepping on the rectangles to get there.  
We want to let Jesus do everything for us...love us, give us His joy and peace, give us His life here on earth and heaven.  
Clap when each child gets to heaven.

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Give them one cloud (or small piece of a cotton ball) to glue in the heart.

Where is heaven?

Up in the sky

So we are going to glue a cloud in the heart

Heaven is a wonderful place.

Let each child choose a foam boy and girl for their craft.

Have them pull the adhesive off the back and place their figures at the bottom of the page.

Jesus made the way for everyone to go to heaven and have His life.

Give each child a baggie of small colored rectangles. (4 blue/4 red/4 yellow)

Have them glue them from the boy/girl up to heaven.

Do we have to work to get to heaven?

NO!

Do we have to do everything right to go to heaven?

NO!

Who gets us to heaven?

JESUS!

Jesus does everything for us!

Give each child a rectangle with the name JESUS on it in red.

Jesus did everything for you because He loves you so much.

Have them glue the name JESUS to the right of the colored rectangles.

Let the children pick out the colored cross of their choice.

(It can be made of plastic, foam or construction paper.)

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Have them glue the cross in the yellow area to the left of Jesus' name.

When you let Jesus do everything for you it makes you happy.  
Give them the smiley face to glue on their craft.

Thank You Jesus for dying on the cross for me. Thank You for washing away my sins. Thank You for setting me free from the lies of the devil. Thank You for giving me Your life. I want everything you have for me!

Pray for any other needs the children have.
